

## 2010 GLBA Year-End Nominations & Rules

Nomination Fees: All Divisions are \$10.00 per Division with the exception of the Pee Wee Division at No Charge.

All Classes are \$10.00 per class \*(capped at \$70.00).

Nomination Options: Both Division(s) and Classes, or just Classes. \*If you want to nominate for more than 7 classes you would only pay for 7 (\$70.00) classes per horse and the rest would be free. This does not include Division nominations. You must pay for all Divisions you'd like to be considered for.

Year End Awards to be given as follows:

Individual Class Awards - 1st (High Point), 2<sup>nd</sup> (Reserve High Point), and 3rd (Honorable Mention).

Divisions High Points: Grand Champion and Reserve Champion

IBHA Open

IBHA Youth

IBHA Amateur

Open All Breed 19 & Over

Open All Breed 13 - 18

Open All Breed 12 & Under

IBHA Halter - this includes all IBHA horses shown in halter for any sex or age

Pee Wee will be awarded Champion, Reserve Champion and Honorable Mention

Rules:

- 1.) Points will not start accumulating until the nomination form, with the applicable fee(s), are turned in.
- 2.) The exhibitor must be a GLBA member in good standing.
- 3.) Points standings will be available at the show, put in the newsletter and on the website.
- 4.) Any point discrepancies should be reported to the Points Secretary for review. Final points will be posted by October 1<sup>st</sup> and exhibitors will have until October 15<sup>th</sup> to report any discrepancies. Points will be considered final/official on October 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 5.) IBHA Open division is on the horse only.
- 6.) IBHA Amateur division is one horse/rider combination.
- 7.) IBHA Youth division is one horse/rider combination.
- 8.) Open All Breed division is one horse/rider combination.
- 9.) Pee Wee division is on the exhibitor only.
- 10.) IBHA Halter division is on the horse only.

\*Please note that the number of classes eligible for awards does not dictate the number of awards a person may be presented.

Individual class awards may be combined into one award...example: one award may be presented with inscription of several year-end placings on it.
